GIFT AID = FREE MONEY!

The beauty of Gift Aid is that it doesn't cost you, the member, anything extra. It is just a means of the Association getting a donation from the Chancellor of the Exchequer and, given the political world's attitude to target shooting, don't you feel that getting the maximum possible contribution from HM Treasury is a step in the right direction?

The simple sum:

For every £1 that you pay under Gift Aid the NSRA gets a further 28p from the Taxman.

If you are a higher-rate taxpayer and include it on your tax return, you can get a rebate of 18p per £ from the taxman as well.

Anyone who pays income tax (on earnings, pension, interest on savings, investment income etc.) or capital gains tax can make Gift Aid payments.

You only need to make one Gift Aid declaration to cover present and future payments (until you countermand it). This will also cover all relevant payments you have made six years prior to this year but not earlier than 6 April 2002.
